

Early Career Prize – Tender 2025

Specialist field

Primary care medicine (including paediatrics and general internal medicine)

Entry conditions

- Submissions can be either a completed research article or a research protocol published or accepted by a peer-reviewed journal in the field of primary health care. Pure research protocols are no longer accepted.
- The main author of the article must belong to the target group (see below)
- Entries must be submitted in English by electronic means and contain the following:
 - a curriculum vitae of the main author
 - the research paper/protocol
- Works which have been previously submitted will not be accepted.
- The Early Career Prize can only be won once.

Research criteria

The submitted work will be judged on three criteria:

- Originality (is it new?)
- Methodology (is it true?)
- Significance (is it important/relevant?)

Prize money

2'000 CHF

The prize money may be awarded to one or several winners.

Target group

The Early Career Prize is awarded to young and future primary care physicians domiciled in Switzerland or Swiss nationals domiciled abroad. Entrants must have passed the state examination no longer than six years before applying for the Early Career Prize.

Project submission

Using the application form on the KHM website.

Entry deadline

31 January 2025

Jury

Independent jury appointed by the KHM board of trustees.

The final decision on awarding the prize is the responsibility of the Board of Trustees. This decision is incontestable and does not have to be justified.

Award ceremony

Takes place as part of the annual KHM continuing education conferences in Lucerne and Lausanne. The winners are invited to present their project.

Rules

The rules, which can be downloaded from the KHM website, are applicable.
