

Start-up Grant - Tender 2026

Specialist field

Primary care medicine (including paediatrics and general internal medicine)

Entry conditions

- > The applicant must belong to the target group (see below).
- > Entries must be submitted in English by electronic means and contain the following:
 - a curriculum vitae of the main author
 - the project description (summary and detail)
 - the requested contribution of the College of Primary Care Medicine
 - a detailed budget
- Works which have been previously submitted will not be accepted
- A Start-up grant won't be allocated to the same person in two consecutive years

Research criteria

The submitted work will be judged on the following criteria:

- Importance/relevance
- Research question
- Methodology
- Feasibility

Contribution

- Maximum 40'000 CHF / project
- A maximum of three projects are supported per year.

Target group

- 1. Young doctors in postgraduate training (general internal medicine and pediatrics) who live in Switzerland or, if they live abroad, are Swiss nationals.
- 2. Doctors who completed their first specialist title no longer than 3 years ago.
- 3. Medical practices or public institutions active in Swiss primary care (family medicine and pediatrics).

Important: Point 3 must be strictly fulfilled, in combination with point 1 or 2.

Project submission

Entry deadline

31 january 2026

Jury

Independent jury appointed by the KHM board of trustees

The final decision is the responsibility of the Board of Trustees. This decision is incontestable and does not have to be justified.
